

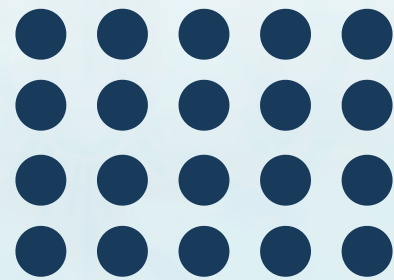

SCIENTIFIC COMPETITION



• GENERAL INFORMATION

- Abstracts are submitted online through the official Bali Neurology Update website.
- Submissions through other methods are not valid.
- Abstracts submitted over the deadline will not be processed further.
- The main author of the manuscript is a participant who has registered and must have paid in full for participation in The 11th Bali Neurology Update.
- The committee has the right to publish the scientific papers that have been submitted in the proceedings book of The 11th Bali Neurology Update with ISSN number.
- Participants are required to comply with the writing guidelines and other announcements published on the official Bali Neurology Update website.
- The final decision on acceptance of abstracts is determined by the committee and is absolute (cannot be contested).
- This competition consists of three stages including abstract collection and selection, submission of complete manuscripts, and oral presentations for selected participants.
- Each stage has guidelines and time limits as outlined on the official Bali Neurology Update website.





SCIENTIFIC COMPETITION



• ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Abstracts are allowed to take themes from all branches of science in the field of Neurology, can be in the form of research categories, literature reviews or case reports.
- Abstracts are original articles that have never been published before.
- Abstracts are submitted in two versions, Indonesian and English.
- The abstract format of Research or Literature Review must contain:
 - Background (which also contains the objectives of the research or literature review)
 - Method
 - Result
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Keywords
- The abstract format of Case Report must contain:
 - Background
 - Case report
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Keywords
- The abstract content is written using Times New Roman font size 10 and single line spacing, except for the title section which uses size 14 with the same font type and line spacing.





SCIENTIFIC COMPETITION



• ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Research Articles have been approved by the local ethics committee and Case Reports have been approved by the patient or other person responsible for the patient.
- The abstract contains the results of the scientific article. It is **NOT** permissible to write sentences that indicate the research or case report is still in progress, such as: "**in process**" or "**to be discussed later**".
- The committee has the right to make minor changes to the abstract from grammar without changing the content.
- The registered main author must ensure that they have obtained approval regarding the content and participation of the manuscript in the 11th Bali Neurology Update 2025 event from all contributing authors.
- The maximum abstract document size is 500 kb and is collected in .pdf format.
- Abstract submission time: July 1, 2025 to September 25, 2025 at 23.59 WITA, and then a selection will be carried out.
- All participants must submit complete manuscripts according to the applicable stages.
- There is no word limit on the abstract, but the abstract is expected to provide brief, concise and clear information.





SCIENTIFIC COMPETITION



• FULL PAPER GUIDELINES

- The full manuscript is written using Times New Roman font size 12 with 1.5 line spacing except for the Title and Abstract sections which use the previous provisions.
- Full paper is written in Indonesian except for the Title and Abstract sections are written in Bahasa AND English.
- Full paper should be written according to academic writing rules. Avoid using unfamiliar terms, abbreviations or units.
- Research and literature review full paper category must include:
 - Title
 - Abstract
 - Introduction
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Bibliography
- Case report full paper category must include:
 - Title
 - Abstract
 - Introduction
 - Case report
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Bibliography
- Citations and Bibliography are written using the Vancouver system.
- The maximum size of the full paper manuscript document is 5MB and is collected in .doc or .docx format.
- The full manuscript must not exceed 2000 words, excluding the Title, Abstract, Figures/Graphs, Tables, and References.
- Figures/Graphs and Tables should be embedded within the text, accompanied by captions and also explained within the narrative.
- A maximum of four (4) figures/graphs and/or tables are allowed in the complete manuscript (in any combination, e.g., 2 figures and 2 tables or 1 figure and 3 tables).
- The full manuscript file should be saved and named as follows: First author's last name_article title_NL (for example: Indah_Stroke Iskemik pada Dewasa Muda_NL.docx).
- The participant can only submit once and the committee will not accept revision for the full paper. Any delay in the full paper submission will be disqualified.

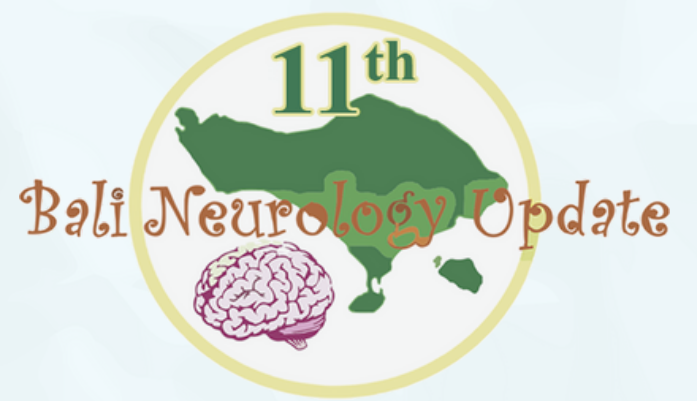
• ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Selected participants are asked to create a presentation document in the form of PowerPoint slides containing a complete summary of the script.
- The maximum presentation document size is 5 MB and is submitted in .ppt or .pptx format.
- The duration of the oral presentation will be 5 minutes, followed by a 15-minute question and answer session by the assessment team.
- Each participant will be assessed by 3 judges based on the criteria determined by the committee.
- The winners will be announced at the closing ceremony of The 11th Bali Neurology Update 2025

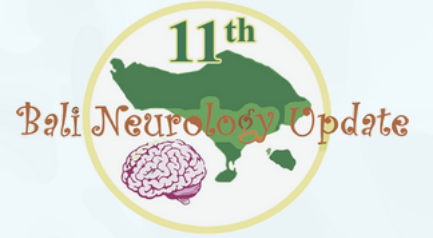
